

Approaches to Learning Activity for 36 to 42 Months

Free Exploration

This activity allows children to experiment with the physical properties of blocks, using their problem-solving skills to build.

Materials:

- Assortment of wooden blocks
- Soft-foam blocks
- Small cars and trucks
- Small road signs

What to do:

- 1. Encourage the child to experiment with building, using both types of blocks.
- 2. Encourage her to use the cars and trucks as she builds.
- 3. Encourage the child to use her imagination and build whatever she wants. Also encourage her to share the blocks with playmates and work together to build.
- 4. Encourage thinking and creativity: "Tell me about what you are building. Where did you get that idea? How do you decide which blocks to use?"
